

KNEE WALKER HIRE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF EQUIPMENT

The knee walker is a therapeutic device to assist injured and/or temporarily disabled people. It is not a recreational device.

It is a breach of the Hire Agreement to allow or authorise any person other than the injured person it was hired for to use the knee walker.

The knee walker must only be used for the purpose for which it is intended.

The knee walker must only be used on a smooth, level surface.

The knee walker must not be taken into the shower.

The knee walker must not be used on a public road.

The knee walker must always be used with care and attention.

When using the knee walker, the operator should be suitably attired to ensure safety of operation and protection.

The knee walker must not be used at greater than walking pace.

Any use of the knee walker by anyone other than the hirer is a breach of the Hire Agreement.

There are obvious and inherent risks in the misuse of the knee walker and great care should be exercised to ensure that no misuse occurs.
